

CEMEX is proposing to develop its former gravel extraction site to the north of Coldharbour Lane and east of Ten Acre Lane in Thorpe to provide facilities open to the community alongside new homes.

This leaflet provides you with details of the proposals and how you can comment on them in advance of a planning application being submitted to Runnymede Borough Council. The proposals include:

- A public park (10.16 ha)
 - A multi-use community area (open space) to accommodate sports or events (1.47 ha)
 - A public car park (c. 44 spaces) to serve the village and Cemetery
 - A new equipped play area
 - Around 40 new homes including affordable homes
 - An extension to Thorpe Cemetery is already planned and is shown on our plans for context.
